DAY 10 Thursday June 16, 2022

Victoria Fall Alert community projects. Students will have the opportunity to assist the a local classroom educating students about their impact on environment and wildlife impact in their communities by planning games and lessons to enhance the learning experience of the children in the community. Afternoon is Human- Wildlife conflict mitigation lesson and assisting in tracking project

DAY 11 Friday June 17, 2022

Alert conservation field research – this includes behavioral observation, hyena monitoring, predator surveys and elephant research in the game preserves surrounding Victoria Fall. In addition a visit to Victoria Fall wildlife trust a rehabilitation and recovery center to participate in veterinary care.

DAY 12 Saturday June 18, 2022

Return visit and activities with Victoria Fall anti- poaching unit for calls and medical needs of animals on preserve followed by a final reflection session in evening. Students will be given the post survey to collect data on the transformative learning journey and discuss the growth in areas of intercultural competence, global citizenship, personal growth, intellectual growth and the professional development.
