



Namibia 2023 Itinerary

Travel Dates: December 5 -22, 2023

DAY 1 - December 7th

- Arrive at Windhoek. Will be transported by host from airport to Namibia Wildlife Sanctuary (45min-1 hr).
- Will be shown new accommodations and taken on a brief tour of the area.
- Participants will be left to adjust to new surroundings and relax the remainder of the day.
