Travel Dates: 9th May 2025 – 15th May 2025

DAY 1: Thursday, 9th May

- Fly overnight to London

DAY 2: Saturday, 10th May

- Meet tour director at airport
- Check into hotel
- With your expert local guide, you will take a walking tour of London. The tour will include:
 - The Strand, a major thoroughfare in Central London—home to a number of theaters and the Royal Courts of Justice.

 - Enjoy an authentic English fish and chips dinner.

- Take a guided tour of London, including the legislative Houses of Parliament and the famous clock, Big Ben, as well as the lively junction of shops, theaters, and memorials at Piccadilly Circus.
- Visit St. Paul's Cathedral, designed by renowned architect Christopher Wren
- Take in a play at one of London's numerous theaters.
- Enjoy dinner in London

DAY 4: Monday, 12th May

- Traveling outside of London to visit Windsor Castle, the Royal Palace, including St. George's Chapel and the State Apartments.
- The trip includes a visit to mysterious Stonehenge, a UNESCO world heritage site.
- Enjoy dinner in London

DAY 5: Tuesday, 13th May

- Guided tour of the legendary Tower of London, visiting the Yeoman Warders, the famous ravens, and the dazzling crown jewels.
- Cruise the River Thames, where you will observe the Globe Theater, iconic Tower Bridge, and many more famous sites.
- Visit the Royal Observatory, location of the "Prime Meridian."
- Explore Britain's seafaring history at the National Maritime Museum
